### John 17:15-21

<sup>15</sup> "I do not ask Thee to take them out of the world, but to keep them from the evil *one*.

<sup>16</sup> "They are not of the world, even as I am not of the world.

<sup>7</sup> "Sanctify them in the truth; Thy word is truth.

<sup>18</sup> "As Thou didst send Me into the world, I also have sent them into the world.

### John 17:15-21

<sup>6</sup> "Let your light shine before men in such a way that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father who is in heaven.

## Eph 2:10

<sup>10</sup> For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.

## Gal 6:9-10

<sup>9</sup> And let us not lose heart in doing good, for in due time we shall reap if we do not grow weary. <sup>10</sup> So then, while we have opportunity, let us do good to all men, and especially to those who are of the household of the faith.

## 1 Peter 3:15

<sup>5</sup> but sanctify Christ as Lord in your hearts, always *being* ready to make a defense to everyone who asks you to give an account for the hope that is in you, yet with gentleness and reverence;

## Mark 5:1-20

<sup>5</sup> And they came to the other side of the sea, into the country of the Gerasenes. <sup>2</sup> And when He had come out of the boat, immediately a man from the tombs with an unclean spirit met Him, <sup>3</sup> and he had his dwelling among the tombs. And no one was able to bind him anymore, even with a chain; <sup>4</sup> because he had often been bound with shackles and chains, and the chains had been torn apart by him, and the shackles broken in pieces, and no one was strong enough to subdue him. <sup>5</sup> And constantly night and day, among the tombs and in the mountains, he was crying out and gashing himself with stones. <sup>6</sup> And seeing Jesus from a distance, he ran up and bowed down before Him; <sup>7</sup> and crying out with a loud voice, he said, "What do I have to do with You, Jesus, Son of the Most High God? I implore You by God, do not torment me!" <sup>8</sup> For He had been saying to him, "Come out of the man, you unclean spirit!" <sup>9</sup> And He was asking him, "What is your name?" And he said to Him, "My name is Legion; for we are many." <sup>10</sup> And he *began* to entreat Him earnestly not to send them out of the country. <sup>11</sup> Now there was a big herd of swine feeding there on the mountain. <sup>12</sup> And *the demons* entreated Him, saying, "Send us into the swine so that we may enter them." <sup>13</sup> And He gave them permission. And coming out, the unclean spirits entered the swine; and the herd rushed down the steep bank into the sea, about two thousand *of them*; and they were drowned in the sea. <sup>14</sup> And their herdsmen ran away and reported it in the city and *out* in the country. And *the people* came to see what it was that had happened. <sup>15</sup> And they came to Jesus and observed the man who had been demon-possessed sitting down, clothed and in his right mind, the very man who had had the "legion"; and they became frightened. <sup>16</sup> And those who had seen it described to them how it had happened to the demon-possessed man, and *all* about the swine. <sup>17</sup> And they began to entreat Him to depart from their region. <sup>18</sup> And as He was getting into the boat, the man who had been demon-possessed was entreating Him that he might accompany Him. <sup>19</sup> And He did not let him, but He said to him, "Go home to your people and report to them what great things the Lord has done for you, and *how He had mercy on you.*" <sup>20</sup> And he went away and began to proclaim in Decapolis what great things Jesus had done for him; and everyone marveled.

### Rom 10:17

<sup>17</sup> So faith *comes* from hearing, and hearing by the word of Christ.

### Rom 1:16

<sup>16</sup> For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.

### John 1:1

<sup>1</sup> In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

### John 1:14

<sup>14</sup> And the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, glory as of the only begotten from the Father, full of grace and truth.

### Rom 3:23

<sup>23</sup> for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,

### Rom 6:23

<sup>23</sup> For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

### Rom 5:8

<sup>8</sup> But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

### Matt 27:62
