### John 14:23-26

<sup>23</sup> Jesus answered and said to him, "If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word; and My Father will love him, and We will come to him, and make Our abode with him.

### Matt 28:18-20

<sup>18</sup> And Jesus came up and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth.

<sup>19</sup> "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit,

<sup>20</sup> teaching them to observe all that I commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age. "

### 1 Cor 3:3-4

<sup>3</sup> for you are still fleshly. For since there is jealousy and strife among you, are you not fleshly, and are you not walking like mere men? <sup>4</sup>

### 1 Cor 3:11-12

<sup>11</sup> For no man can lay a foundation other than the one which is laid, which is Jesus Christ. <sup>12</sup> Now if any man builds upon the foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw,

#### John 13:34

<sup>34</sup> "A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another, even as I have loved you, that you also love one another.

#### Matt 22:17-21

<sup>17</sup> "Tell us therefore, what do You think? Is it lawful to give a poll-tax to Caesar, or not?" <sup>18</sup> But Jesus perceived their malice, and said, "Why are you testing Me, you hypocrites? <sup>19</sup> "Show Me the coin *used* for the poll-tax." And they brought Him a denarius. <sup>20</sup> And He said to them, "Whose likeness and inscription is this?" <sup>21</sup> They said to Him, "Caesar's." Then He said to them, "Then render to Caesar the things that are Caesar's; and to God the things that are God's."

#### Rom 13:7

<sup>7</sup> Render to all what is due them: tax to whom tax *is due*; custom to whom custom; fear to whom fear; honor to whom honor.

#### Heb 10:24-25

<sup>24</sup> and let us consider how to stimulate one another to love and good deeds, <sup>25</sup> not forsaking our own assembling together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging *one another*; and all the more, as you see the day drawing near.
