- 1. He set the ex\_\_\_\_\_ of making the right choice
- 2. His message to Israel illustrates how we can make the right choice

# **Remember Where You Were (1-4)**

### •Without G

- 1. The nation of Israel was formed from the loins of Abraham, whose family served other g\_\_\_\_\_(v. 2)
- 2. Every person comes into this w\_\_\_\_\_ without God
  - a. I Cor 2:14 the natural man does not accept the things of the Spirit of God...(this is the natural, or b\_\_\_\_\_ state of all humans)
  - b. Eph 2:3 we are by nature children of wrath, even as the rest [of mankind]. (No one is born s\_\_\_\_\_)

# •E

- 1. For 400 years the people of Israel were in E\_\_\_\_\_, enslaved and oppressed (v. 4; Gen 15:13)
- 2. All people at one time were enslaved to s
  - a. Rom 6:17,20 when you were slaves to sin, you were free from righteousness (all we could do was sin).
  - b. Rom 6:19 you presented yourselves as slaves to impurity (we could c\_\_\_\_\_\_ what sins to commit).
  - c. The word "sin" literally means "to miss the m\_\_\_\_\_ (God's mark or standard is that we do everything in relationship to Him)

## **Remember What God Did For You (5-13)**

#### •D\_\_\_\_\_ from slavery

- 1. God did all the w\_\_\_\_\_\_ to free Israel from Egyptian slavery
  - a. He put various p\_\_\_\_\_ on Egypt (v. 5)
  - b. He p\_\_\_\_\_ the Red Sea
  - c. He d\_\_\_\_\_\_ the Egyptian army (v. 7)
- 2. God did all the work to free us from slavery to sin
  - a. He did all the work on the c\_\_\_\_\_(Eph 2:8,9)
  - b. He did all the work in our h
    - 1) Jn 16:8,9 He [the Holy Spirit] will convict the world concerning sin and righteousness and judgment; concerning sin, because they do not believe in Me [Jesus]....
    - 2) Jn 6:44 no one can come to Me [Jesus] unless the Father draws him...

## •Empowered to overcome

- 1. God gave Israel p\_\_\_\_\_ over their enemies (vv. 8-12)
- 2. God gives believers power over s\_\_\_\_\_
  - a. Rom 6:12 do not let sin r\_\_\_\_\_\_ in your mortal body, that you should obey its lusts.
  - b. Heb 12:1 lay aside every hindrance and the sin which so easily entangles us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, fixing our eyes upon J\_\_\_\_\_.
  - c. Rom 12:2 Do not be con\_\_\_\_\_ to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind...

## **Remember Who You Are (14,15)**

•S\_\_\_\_\_ of God

- 1. Joshua challenged the people of Israel to:
  - a. Sever all connections with other g\_\_\_\_\_ (v. 14)
  - b. C\_\_\_\_\_ to serve the Lord (v. 15)
- 2. Every believer is the Lord's servant
  - a. This does NOT mean that every believer is to be a missionary, pastor or teacher

- b. This DOES mean that God wants to accomplish something through us every day (2 Tim 2:21)
- •What God desires to do through each believer will be
  - s\_\_\_\_\_ because God's work is always significant.

**Conclusion** – Try this exercise daily

- 1. Remember where you were spiritually without God, enslaved to sin.
- 2. Remember all the work God did to bring you to Jesus His work on the cross and His work in your heart.
- 3. Remember who you are the Lord's servant.
- 4. Choose this day to serve the Lord He will use you to impact others in Jesus' name.
