

## GO!

(Romans 10:1,2,8-15)

### GO P \_\_\_\_\_ (1)

- The apostle Paul used to persecute the c \_\_\_\_\_ (Acts 9)
  1. Jesus stopped him by striking him b \_\_\_\_\_
  2. Jesus revealed to him the t \_\_\_\_\_ of the gospel
  3. Paul accepted Jesus as Lord and Savior
- The apostle Paul later understood the miracle of his salvation
  1. 2 Cor 4:4 – unbelievers are b \_\_\_\_\_ by Satan
  2. Rom 3:11 – unbelievers cannot s \_\_\_\_\_ God on their own
  3. Salvation requires the supernatural intervention of God
    - a. Jn 6:44 – no one can come to Christ unless the Father d \_\_\_\_\_ them to Christ.
    - b. Jn 16:8 – the Holy Spirit is the one who c \_\_\_\_\_ a person of sin so as to believe.
- Since salvation is a miracle, it is a matter of p \_\_\_\_\_
  1. Rom 10:1 – Paul p \_\_\_\_\_ for the salvation of his fellow Jew, because he knew that only God could save them
  2. Will you pray about missions in general?
    - a. There are about 12,000 people g \_\_\_\_\_ in the world (classified this way because of Rev 5:9,10).
    - b. 3400 of them are un \_\_\_\_\_ (i.e. they have not gospel presence)
  3. Will you pray for the lost specifically?
    - a. List five people you are most connected with that are not believers.
    - b. Pray for them – pray for a miracle!
      - 1) On a regular basis (daily, weekly)
      - 2) Whenever you see them

### GO T \_\_\_\_\_ (13,14)

- Paul gives a series of rhetorical questions (questions that have such an obvious answer that the answer need not be given)
  1. How will a person call upon the Lord if they do not believe in Him? Answer - they c \_\_\_\_\_
  2. How will a person believe in the Lord if they have not heard about Him? Answer – they c \_\_\_\_\_
    - a. Does it seem fair that people who die without ever hearing the name of Jesus go to hell?

- 1) Rom 1:19,20 states all are without e\_\_\_\_\_
- 2) Condemnation is f\_\_\_\_\_
- b. S\_\_\_\_\_ is not fair; it is grace!
3. How can a person hear about Jesus without a p\_\_\_\_\_?  
Answer – they c\_\_\_\_\_
  - a. “Preacher” literally means one who makes an  
a\_\_\_\_\_
    - 1) This is not restricted to missionaries or evangelists
    - 2) This is the responsibility of e\_\_\_\_\_ believer  
(Acts 1:8; 1 Pet 2:9)
  - b. This does not mean that we go door to door but that we  
look for o\_\_\_\_\_ to tell (see Col 4:3)
    - 1) Look for opportunities to tell about Christ when people  
come to you with their problems.
    - 2) Look for opportunities to tell about Christ when people  
begin conversing about “religious” things.
    - 3) Keep a tract handy to give at an opportune time

### GO G \_\_\_\_\_ (15)

- Paul gives a final question: *How can a person preach unless they are s\_\_\_\_\_?* Answer: they c\_\_\_\_\_
  1. The sender is ultimately G\_\_\_\_\_
  2. God uses the s\_\_\_\_\_ of the church to send missionaries across the world (e.g. Acts 13:2-4)
- Giving is essential to world missions
  1. Southern Baptists have the l\_\_\_\_\_ missionary force (over 5,000 foreign missionaries in over 150 countries) – they are salaried so they can stay on the field and not spend precious time raising funds.
  2. Southern Baptists have an aggressive global s\_\_\_\_\_ of reaching unreached people groups.
  3. Two main sources fund mission activity
    - a. The Coop\_\_\_\_\_ Program
    - b. The Lottie Moon Ch\_\_\_\_\_ Offering
  4. If every Southern Baptist had an extra \$1 to give but did not give it because they thought it too insignificant, \$16 million would not be given – Together We Make A B\_\_\_\_\_ Difference!
