# 10-11-15 Scripture Reading

### 1 Cor 12:1-11

- <sup>1</sup>Now concerning spiritual *gifts*, brethren, I do not want you to be unaware.
- <sup>2</sup> You know that when you were pagans, *you were* led astray to the dumb idols, however you were led.
- <sup>3</sup> Therefore I make known to you, that no one speaking by the Spirit of God says, "Jesus is accursed"; and no one can say, "Jesus is Lord," except by the Holy Spirit.
- <sup>4</sup> Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit.
- <sup>5</sup> And there are varieties of ministries, and the same Lord.
- <sup>6</sup> And there are varieties of effects, but the same God who works all things in all *persons*.
- <sup>7</sup> But to each one is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good.
- <sup>8</sup> For to one is given the word of wisdom through the Spirit, and to another the word of knowledge according to the same Spirit;
- <sup>9</sup> to another faith by the same Spirit, and to another gifts of healing by the one Spirit,
- <sup>10</sup> and to another the effecting of miracles, and to another prophecy, and to another the distinguishing of spirits, to another *various* kinds of tongues, and to another the interpretation of tongues.
- <sup>11</sup> But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually just as He wills.

# Ex 7:9-13

9 "When Pharaoh speaks to you, saying, 'Work a miracle,' then you shall say to Aaron, 'Take your staff and throw *it* down before Pharaoh, *that* it may become a serpent." <sup>10</sup> So Moses and Aaron came to Pharaoh, and thus they did just as the LORD had commanded; and Aaron threw his staff down before Pharaoh and his servants, and it became a serpent. <sup>11</sup> Then Pharaoh also called for *the* wise men and *the* sorcerers, and they also, the magicians of Egypt, did the same with their secret arts. <sup>12</sup> For each one threw down his staff and they turned into serpents. # 1 John 4:1

4 Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are from God; because many false prophets have gone out into the world.

<sup>16</sup> And it happened that as we were going to the place of prayer, a certain slavegirl having a spirit of divination met us, who was bringing her masters much profit by fortunetelling. <sup>17</sup> Following after Paul and us, she kept crying out, saying, "These men are bond-servants of the Most High God, who are proclaiming to you the way of salvation." <sup>18</sup> And she continued doing this for many days. But Paul was greatly annoyed, and turned and said to the spirit, "I command you in the name of Jesus Christ to come out of her!" And it came out at that very moment.
