### A Spiritual Gift is Given By God To Believers Only (3,6)

• Verse 3 – through the grace given me, I say...

- 1. In this context, the word "grace" does NOT refer to salvation but to a spiritual g\_\_\_\_\_

  - - 2) An apostle or prophet did not decide when to prophesy (2Pet 1:21a) no prophecy was ever made by an act of human w\_\_\_\_\_.
      3) An apostle or prophet was c\_\_\_\_\_\_ to prophesy by the Holy Spirit (2Pet 1:21b) – but
    - men m\_\_\_\_\_ by the Holy Spirit spoke from God.
  - b. Paul wrote this letter under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit (2Tim 3:16) and so the gift he is exercising is p
- 2. Through the grace given me (the gift of prophecy), I say...

  - a. This letter is not Paul's o\_\_\_\_\_\_b. This letter is God's w\_\_\_\_\_\_ (are you listening?)

### •Verse 6

- 1. Notice the similarity in language with verse 3
  - a. Paul is prophesying *through the grace given him* (v.3) We have gifts according to the grace given us (v. 6)
  - b. God has allotted to each a measure of faith (v. 3) We are to exercise our gifts according to the proportion
    - *of our faith* (v. 6)
- 2. Why is *according to faith* emphasized?
- a. Because many exercise gifts in p\_\_\_\_\_ (v. 3 think too highly of self).
  b. Without faith we cannot p\_\_\_\_\_ God (Heb 11:6)
- •From verses 3 and 6 we learn
  - 1. A spiritual gift is given by G\_\_\_\_\_
  - A spiritual gift is un\_\_\_\_\_ (grace)
     A spiritual gift is given only to b\_\_\_\_\_\_ in Christ

### A Spiritual Gift is Given by God to Serve the Body (4,5)

•The human body illustrates how spiritual gifts work

- 1. The illustration (v. 4)
  - a. Our body is made up of many p\_\_\_\_\_
  - b. The parts has different f\_\_\_\_\_
- 2. The application (v. 5)
  - a. The local church is made up of many m\_\_\_\_\_

- b. We make up one b\_\_\_\_\_
- c. We b\_\_\_\_\_\_ to each other
- The spiritual body of Christ is called the church (Col 1:18) and
  - is viewed in two ways:
  - 1. The u\_\_\_\_\_ body
    - a. There is only o\_\_\_\_\_ (Eph 4:4)
    - b. As soon as a person comes to Christ they become a member of the universal body of Christ (I Cor 12:14)
  - 2. The l\_\_\_\_\_ body a. There are m\_\_\_\_\_ (Rom 16:16)
    - a. There are m\_\_\_\_\_ (Rom 10:10)
      b. A believer should identify with a particular local church so that he/she can use their spiritual gift.

## What Are the Spiritual Gifts? (6-8)

- •S\_\_\_\_\_ gifts are listed in verses 6-8
  - 1. I Cor 12:8-10 lists n\_\_\_\_\_ spiritual gifts
  - 2. Eph 4:11 list f\_\_\_\_\_ kinds of leaders not additional gifts (prophet is a person, prophecy is the spiritual gift)
- •Comparing the lists of Rom 12:6-8 with 1Cor 12:8-10
- 1. What gift do they have in common? p\_\_\_\_\_
- 2. Why are the lists so different?
  - a. 1Cor 12:8-10 lists **spectacular** gifts that are a t\_\_\_\_\_ possession (one has the gift only during the time it is in use)
    - 1) 1Cor 12:11 states that the Spirit d\_\_\_\_\_\_ these gifts (present tense not past tense)
    - 2) 1Cor 12:11 states that the Spirit distributes these spectacular gifts as He w\_\_\_\_\_
      - a) There are two Greek words translated as "will"
        - #1 One refers to merely w\_\_\_\_\_; does God always get what He wills or wishes? – He does not will you to sin but you do!
        - #2 The other refers to the working of a determined p\_\_\_\_\_ (we fail at this but God does not and no one can resist His determined plan Rom 9:19)
      - b) The Greek word in 1Cor 12:11 is #2
        - i. Acts 2:1-8 the gift of tongues was given to the 120 disciples only for the duration of the speaking; they could not decide to speak in tongues at any time.
        - ii. 2Tim 4:20 Paul left his traveling companion behind s\_\_\_\_\_ (Paul healed others, why not him? The Spirit did not distribute the gift of healing to Paul at that time)
        - iii. Jer 20:9 Jeremiah tried not to prophecy but he could not hold it in.
  - b. Rom 12:7,8 lists **stewardship** gifts that are a p\_\_\_\_\_ possession (we have until death).
    - 1) 1Pet 4:10 we have to choose to be a good s\_\_\_\_\_\_ of these gifts
    - 2) 1Pet 4:10 we have to choose to use these gifts in s\_\_\_\_\_\_ each other
    - 3) 1Pet 4:11 we must exercise these gifts in a manner that g\_\_\_\_\_ God.
