- •Who you are in relationship to God
  - 1. Jn 1:12 His c\_\_\_\_\_
  - 2. I Cor 1:2 A saint by His c
    - a. The word saint means "one set apart for service"

    - b. Who set us apart? \_\_\_\_\_c. Why are we set apart? to s\_\_\_\_\_ God

•Who you are in relationship to the world (Matt 5:13-16)

- 1. You are s\_\_\_\_\_
  - When impurities combine with salt, it ceases to be a.
  - s\_\_\_\_\_;b. Jesus uses "unsalty salt" to show the ridiculousness of us not fulfilling our purpose in relationship to the world
- 2. You are l
  - Jesus shows the impossibility of h\_\_\_\_\_a city a. set on a hill (it is visible in the day because of the s\_\_\_\_\_ and at night because of the many 1)
  - b. Jesus shows the ridiculousness of l a lamp then hiding the light.
- 3. We are visible to the world through our g\_\_\_\_\_ works (that they may see your good works)
  - a. Good works are not just nice deeds (unbelievers can do nice deeds but they cannot do good works in the biblical sense)
  - b. Good works are not just r\_\_\_\_\_ deeds (see Matt 7:21-23, where they are considered sinful)

- c. Good works are deeds that G\_\_\_\_\_ wants us to do in relationship to Christ (see Jn 15:5).
- 4. God uses our good works as a p\_\_\_\_\_ for the unbelieving world to come to Him through Christ (*and glorify your Father, who is in heaven*).

#### Your Possession – What You H\_\_\_\_\_ (Jn 17:3)

- The gift God gives us is eternal life through Christ. But what is eternal life?
  - 1. To k\_\_\_\_\_\_ the one true God (the Greek word means to know personally)
  - 2. To k\_\_\_\_\_\_ His Son, whom He has sent (to know personally).
  - 3. Therefore eternal life is a permanent relationship with God through Jesus Christ.
- •God gave us Himself in Christ not so that we could keep Him to ourself but s\_\_\_\_\_ Him with others.

# Your Participation – What You D\_\_\_\_\_(Acts 1:8)

- •The Acts 1:8 strategy of being Christ's witnesses
  - 1. In Jerusalem
    - a. Jerusalem was where the disciples were when Jesus gave the command.
    - b. Therefore your Jerusalem is wherever you l\_\_\_\_\_, shop, work, etc.
  - 2. In Judea
    - a. Jerusalem was in the r\_\_\_\_\_ of Judea
    - b. Therefore your Judea would correspond to your S\_\_\_\_\_ (e.g. Michigan)
    - c. As we cooperate in mission work and people are brought to Christ, those people are to be witnesses in their Jerusalem, where they are at.
  - 3. In Samaria
    - a. Samaria was a region neighboring Judea that was populated by a group that the Jews h\_\_\_\_\_ (Jn 4:9)
    - b. Therefore your Samaria refers to the undesirables of the world (e.g. the homeless, the drug addicts, the ghetto).
    - c. Those that come to Christ then become witnesses to their Jerusalem, where they are at.

4. To the ends of the earth - the rest of the w\_\_\_\_\_ (every tribe, tongue, nation, and class – Rev 5:9,10)

•Everything comes back to being witnesses where we are at

- 1. There are many tools available to help us all get the gospel before those around us.
- 2. Let's try the truelife.org tool and see what happens.
  - a. If people come to the church they will be exposed to the gospel (and the gospel is the power of God for salvation)
  - b. If people check out any question on the website, they will be exposed to the gospel (and the gospel is the power of God for salvation)
