## **ARE YOU COMPLETELY CONVINCED?**

Romans 8:35-39

## **Introduction:**

- •What does it require to be 100% certain of your eternal destiny?
- 1. To know the c\_\_\_\_\_ of God
- 2. To rely ONLY on what God s\_\_\_\_\_
- •The apostle Paul was completely convinced of two incredible truths for all believers in Christ. Are you completely convinced?

## Nothing Can Separate You From Christ's Love For You

- •Verse 36 is a quote from Ps 44:22
  - 1. This psalm is about the people of Israel suffering humiliating attacks from their enemies.
    - a. Israelites were being killed all d long
    - b. Israelites were being slaughtered like s\_\_\_\_\_
  - 2. The people wondered if God still loved them.
    - a. This is the classic mistake of viewing God through our ex\_\_\_\_\_.
    - b. We must draw our conclusions about God by His word!
- •No c\_\_\_\_\_ can separate believers from Christ's love
- 1. List circumstances that deny one of some privileges (v. 35):
  - t\_\_\_\_\_ d\_\_\_\_(NIV hardship) p\_\_\_\_\_\_ see 2Cor 11:24,25; Acts 14:19

    - S

Do not measure God's love by what people DO TO you but by what Christ DID f\_\_\_\_\_ you! He d\_\_\_\_\_ for you and erased all s\_\_\_\_\_ from your record!

2. List circumstances that deny one of some needs (v. 35)

f\_\_\_\_\_\_ n\_\_\_\_ - 2 Cor 11:27 p\_\_\_\_\_\_ (NIV - danger) - 2 Cor 11:26

Do not measure God's love by what is TAKEN FROM you but what God G\_\_\_\_\_you. He gave us His only Son!

- 3. The final circumstance denies one of his 1 (v. 38) *D\_\_\_\_\_* cannot separate believers from Christ's love
- •No c\_\_\_\_\_ can separate believers from Christ's love
- 1. H\_\_\_\_\_ power cannot (God has not greatly limited this power)
- 2. D\_\_\_\_\_ power cannot (God has greatly limited this power Job, I Jn 5:18)
- •T & distance cannot separate believers from Christ's love

## You Are More Than A Conqueror Through Christ

•Verse 37 states that there is no c\_\_\_\_\_ between

believers in Christ and and any adversity.

- 1. We are m\_\_\_\_\_ than a conqueror (NAS overwhelmingly conquer)
- 2. The conquering is t\_\_\_\_\_ Christ who loves us.
- •If this is true, then why do we sometimes (circle your experience):
  - feel discouraged get mad have doubts

let circumstances get the best of us

- God will not allow this attitude to p\_\_\_\_\_ in believers (Jms 1:2-4)
   a. Tests are allowed by God so that we WILL p\_\_\_\_\_ them not fail them. (e.g. how many times will your patience have to be tried before you will pass the test?)
  - b. Allow trials to have their God-intended effect (improved c\_\_\_\_\_)

- 2. We do not become conquerors by conquering our circumstances
  - a. Believers are not to conquer their persecutors (do persecutors win?)

  - b. Many believers are k\_\_\_\_\_\_ for their faith (did martyrs lose?)
    c. Believers suffer injustice such as rape, incest, wrongful imprisonment (do they lose?)
- 3. We will not BECOME conquerors but ALREADY ARE conquerors through C\_\_\_\_\_\_ who loved us (v. 37)
  - a. This act of love points back to the c\_\_\_\_\_ (that is why love is in the past tense).
  - b. Everything was s\_\_\_\_\_\_ for believers at the cross the outcome has been predetermined

Since NOTHING will separate us from Christ's love, then we ARE more than conquerers through Christ's work of love on the cross.
