## WHERE IS A TREE OF LIFE?

Proverbs 11:30

## **Introduction:**

•When Adam and Eve sinned:

- 1. They were kicked out of the g\_\_\_\_\_
- 2. The tree of life was g\_\_\_\_\_\_ so no one would have access to it.

•However, a tree of life can be seen!

- 1. Those who have f\_\_\_\_\_\_ in God are called a tree of life.
- 2. If someone were to look for a tree of life, could they find one in you?

In Your Witness of W\_\_\_\_\_(30a)

•F\_\_\_\_\_ on a tree is a common metaphor for what characterizes people (Matt 7:20 – *you will k\_\_\_\_\_\_ them by their fruits*)

- 1. Character of an unbeliever derived from various sources
- 2. Character of a believer
  - a. Derived from their faith r\_\_\_\_\_ to Jesus
  - b. Demonstrated in a\_\_\_\_\_ that flows from that relationship
- •Analyze your life
  - 1. What fruit do you think that you are manifesting?
  - 2. What fruit do others see in you?

## In Your Witness of W\_\_\_\_\_(30b)

- •Our words must be w\_\_\_\_\_
  - 1. Starting point the f\_\_\_\_\_\_ of the Lord (a deep reverence for who the Lord is in relationship to you)
  - 2. Source God's w\_\_\_\_\_

•A wise person wins s\_\_\_\_\_

- 1. Literal meaning of "win" (NIV translates as "saves") to take by the use of l
- 2. Contextual meaning working to bring a person to eternal l\_\_\_\_\_ (which is a relationship with God through Jesus Jn 17:3)
- 3. This does not mean that wisdom is measured by how many people you have brought to Christ (the results are God's w\_\_\_\_)

•Ways to be a verbal witness

1. P\_\_\_\_\_ contact – take opportunities to point people to Christ (pray daily for opportunities and watch)

- 2. F\_\_\_\_\_ contact giving is not a matter of dollars and cents but of the heart (offerings support mission work)
- 3. S\_\_\_\_\_natural contact pray for the salvation of lost people that you know (who was the only U.S. president to come to Christ while in office?)
