He has sent Me to proclaim release to the captives,

And recovery of sight to the blind,

## Isa 61

**61** The Spirit of the Lord GoD is upon me, Because the LORD has anointed me To bring good news to the afflicted;

He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted,

To proclaim liberty to captives,

And freedom to prisoners;

<sup>2</sup> To proclaim the favorable year of the LORD,

And the day of vengeance of our God;

To comfort all who mourn,

<sup>3</sup> To grant those who mourn in Zion,

Giving them a garland instead of ashes,

The oil of gladness instead of mourning,

The mantle of praise instead of a spirit of fainting.

So they will be called oaks of righteousness,

The planting of the LORD, that He may be glorified.

<sup>4</sup> Then they will rebuild the ancient ruins,

They will raise up the former devastations,

And they will repair the ruined cities,

The desolations of many generations.

<sup>5</sup> And strangers will stand and pasture your flocks,

And foreigners will be your farmers and your vinedressers.

<sup>6</sup> But you will be called the priests of the LORD;

You will be spoken of as ministers of our God.

You will eat the wealth of nations.

And in their riches you will boast.

<sup>7</sup> Instead of your shame you will have a double portion,

And *instead of* humiliation they will shout for joy over their portion.

Therefore they will possess a double *portion* in their land,

Everlasting joy will be theirs.

8 For I, the LORD, love justice,

I hate robbery in the burnt offering;

And I will faithfully give them their recompense,

And I will make an everlasting covenant with them.

<sup>9</sup> Then their offspring will be known among the nations,

And their descendants in the midst of the peoples.

All who see them will recognize them

Because they are the offspring whom the LORD has blessed.

<sup>10</sup> I will rejoice greatly in the LORD,

My soul will exult in my God;

For He has clothed me with garments of salvation,

He has wrapped me with a robe of righteousness,

As a bridegroom decks himself with a garland,

And as a bride adorns herself with her jewels.

<sup>11</sup> For as the earth brings forth its sprouts,

And as a garden causes the things sown in it to spring up,

So the Lord God will cause righteousness and praise

To spring up before all the nations.

#### John 20:25

25 The other disciples therefore were saying to him, "We have seen the Lord!" But he said to them, "Unless I shall see in His hands the imprint of the nails, and put my finger into the place of the nails, and put my hand into His side, I will not believe."

#### Matt 27:26

## Matt 27:57-60
