- •Jesus said in Jn 14:12: the works that He does, the believer will do also. Are you doing the works that Christ does?
 - 1. Notice that Jesus did NOT say that we will do the works He HAS DONE (past tense) but that He DOES (present tense) or the works that He

 - 3. Therefore, the works that we believers do are to be the works Jesus does through us, for without Him we can do n_____ (Jn 15:5)
- •Jesus promised in Jn 14:12 that believers will do GREATER works than these because He is going to the Father.
 - 1. What works did Jesus work through the disciples? (h_____, casting out demons, telling people that the kingdom of God was near Lk 10:9,16).

 - b. What Jesus accomplished through believers while He was on earth was GREAT, but what He would accomplish through believers while He's in heaven will be GREATER. Jesus already told them what the greater works would be -s (Jn 5:20-24).
 - 3. The greatest work that can be done through us is using us to bring salvation to the lost.

Interpretive paraphrase: Every believer will do the works of Christ as Christ works through them. And every believer will do the greater works of Christ because the Holy Spirit works through them. Faith is depending on Christ to work through you, for without Him you can do nothing! If He invites you, join Him in faith and watch Him work!
