# **God Speaks Through the Bible**

Unit 5 Day 4 of Experiencing God

Introduction: Henry Blackaby proposes that the Holy Spirit speaks through the Bible. This raises a few questions.

## How is the Bible God's Word when it was written by men?

- 1. It was already in written form for well over \_\_\_\_\_ years before Jesus was born.
  - a. It was translated into G\_\_\_\_\_ around 250 B.C.
  - b. By the time of Jesus, the O.T. was well circulated among the Jewish synagogues in two languages.
- 2. Records prophecies about the Messiah that only Jesus fulfilled.
  - a. Micah 5:2 where He would be b\_\_\_\_\_
  - b. Is 7:14 the nature of His conception a v\_\_\_\_\_ conception.
  - c. Dan 9:24-27 the time frame of the completion of the Messiah's ministry in putting an end to sin as being \_\_\_\_\_\_ years after a certain decree made in 457 B.C.
  - d. Is 53 gives a remarkable description of the crucifixion as well as being buried in a r tomb.

#### How is the Bible God's Word to me when it was written to others?

- 1. Jesus stated to the Sadducees in Matt 22:31,32: have you not read what was spoken to you by God and then quotes Ex 3:6, which was a record of what was spoken to M\_\_\_\_\_
  - a. Jesus viewed the Scriptures as God s\_\_\_\_\_ to us.
- b. I must view the Bible as God's w\_\_\_\_\_\_ to me.
  2. We must take responsibility to u\_\_\_\_\_\_ what God has already spoken (e.g. Phil 4:13 – *I* can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.)
  - a. Put yourself in the time and culture of the author and the audience so you can understand it as o\_\_\_\_\_ intended.
  - b. Put it in c\_\_\_\_\_ to see how it fits with the surrounding verses.
  - c. A it to your life.

# How does God speak to me by the Holy Spirit through the Bible?

1. 1Cor 2:11,12 – the Holy Spirit is within you, ready to i\_\_\_\_\_ with the scripture to speak to you

- 2. 2Tim 3:16 the Holy Spirit will do at least one of four things

    d. E\_\_\_\_\_\_ you for a task in serving Him
- 3. If you are reading the Word daily, God will speak to you daily.

- 2. Col 3:16 Let the word of Christ richly dwell within you Are you ENRICHING yourself?
- 3. Eph 6:17 part of the armor needed to fight off Satan and his demons is the sword of the Spirit called the word of God. - Are you ARMING yourself with God's word?
