<sup>22</sup> "And *if* men struggle with each other and strike a woman with child so that she has a miscarriage, yet there is no *further* injury, he shall surely be fined as the woman's husband may demand of him; and he shall pay as the judges *decide*.

**Ex 21:22-25 (NIV)**

<sup>22</sup> "If men who are fighting hit a pregnant woman and she gives birth prematurely<sup>e</sup> but there is no serious injury, the offender must be fined whatever the woman's husband demands and the court allows.

<sup>23</sup> But if there is serious injury, you are to take life for life,

<sup>24</sup> eye for eye, tooth for tooth, hand for hand, foot for foot,

<sup>25</sup> burn for burn, wound for wound, bruise for bruise.

<sup>13</sup> For you created my inmost being;  
you knit me together in my mother's womb.  
<sup>14</sup> I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made;

when I was made in the secret place.  
When I was woven together in the depths of the earth,

### **Ex 21:22-25 (NLT)**

<sup>22</sup> "Now suppose two men are fighting, and in the process they accidentally strike a pregnant woman so she gives birth prematurely.\* If no further injury results, the man who struck the woman must pay the amount of compensation the woman's husband demands and the judges approve.

<sup>23</sup> But if there is further injury, the punishment must match the injury: a life for a life,

<sup>24</sup> an eye for an eye, a tooth for a tooth, a hand for a hand, a foot for a foot,

<sup>25</sup> a burn for a burn, a wound for a wound, a bruise for a bruise.

### **Ps 139:13-16 (NLT)**

<sup>13</sup> You made all the delicate, inner parts of my body  
and knit me together in my mother's womb.  
<sup>14</sup> Thank you for making me so wonderfully complex!  
Your workmanship is marvelous—how well I know it.  
<sup>15</sup> You watched me as I was being formed in utter seclusion,  
as I was woven together in the dark of the womb.  
<sup>16</sup> You saw me before I was born.  
Every day of my life was recorded in your book.  
Every moment was laid out  
before a single day had passed.
