# Obedience P\_\_\_\_\_ Experiencing God

•Don't confuse this with salvation (Eph 2:8,9)

- 1. Obedience does not result in s\_\_\_\_\_
- 2. Salvation results in o\_\_\_\_\_
- •Once we are saved obedience is a s\_\_\_\_\_
  - 1. Believers have two n\_\_\_\_\_ (Eph 4:22-24)
    - a. The o\_\_\_\_\_\_ seeks to satisfy self
    - b. The n\_\_\_\_\_ seeks to glorify God
  - 2. As we keep the new nature on (obeying God), then we will begin to experience Him in different ways.

### Biblical Examples

- 1. David experienced God working through him in defeating Goliath (1Sam 17:45-47)
- 2. The Jerusalem Christians experienced God working through them to meet the needs of the 3000 new believers (Acts 2:42-46)

•Our part is not to hunt for what God wants us to do for Him. It is to be obedient so that God can work through us.

## Disobedience F\_\_\_\_\_ Experiencing God

•How many chances does God give us to obey before we forfeit experiencing Him in a certain way?

- 1. He certainly will d\_\_\_\_\_\_ us in a loving way (Rev 3:19)
- 2. The number of chances God gives is up to \_\_\_\_\_
  - a. Jonah rebelled \_\_\_\_\_\_ times but still was used by God to bring Nineveh to repentance (Jonah 2)
  - b. Moses refused to be the public speaker. He was given \_\_\_\_\_ chances to accept (Ex 4:10-14)
  - c. God intended to use Moses to lead Israel into the promised forfeited this privilege because He publicly struck the rock in a\_\_\_\_\_ (Numbers 20:8-12).
  - d. God planned to use the church of Philadelphia to bring the traditional Jews of that town to Christ and warned them, *See to it that no one*

\_\_\_\_\_ *your crown* (Rev 3:7-9)

- 1) the Greek word can be translated as *take* or *receive*).
- 2) The Bible only gives the picture of God g\_\_\_\_\_ "crowns" originally intended for one person to another.

- 3) It never pictures believers \_\_\_\_\_\_ another persons crown.
- 4) Notice that Paul called the Philippian church and the Thessalonian church his c\_\_\_\_\_ (Phil 4:1; 1Thess 2:19).
- e. God intended to use Moses to lead people into the
