a. Sometimes God w for us to ask before He acts (James 4:2)
1) He gave Solomon w because He asked (I Kgs 3:7-12)
2) He gave Hezekiah 15 more of life because he asked (I Kgs
20:1-6)
3) God gave Samson superhuman because he asked (Jdg 16:28-30)
b. Sometimes He acts without our asking
1) Provided for the people of Israel in their 40 years in the wilderness – their
clothing and s would not wear out.
2) What has God provided for you?
3. Thank God that He does infinitely above what we ask or think!

a. Power – translates a Greek word where we get our word d (explosive!)
b. Works – translates a Greek word where we get our word e (energizing! – see Col 1:29)

b. God does not bypass a human vessel to demonstrate His power and to accomplish
His p

1. That directly relates to His power? Jesus said in Matt 5:14 we are l
to the world
2. That we must do because of who we are? Jesus said in Matt 5:16 that we must let
that light shine by doing g works = God's will.
a. God gives us the d – Phil 2:13a
b. God gives us the p – Phil 2:13b
3. That His plan is for the church? – Eph 3:20 – to be g (this
is done when we remember who we are and why we are here).
