#### The Call of Christ

Matthew 9:9-13

#### Introduction:

- •Jesus did NOT come into the world to c\_\_\_\_\_ it (Jn 3:17a)
  - 1. All the world has s\_\_\_\_\_ against God
  - 2. Therefore, the world was already c\_\_\_\_\_
- •Jesus came into the world to s\_\_\_\_\_\_ it from condemnation (Jn 3:17b)
  - 1. This requires Him to bring people into a r\_\_\_\_\_ relationship with God
  - 2. The involves Him personally c\_\_\_\_\_ people to follow Him.
- •The call of Christ:

# Is an undeserved gift (9)

•Jesus called Matthew to follow Him

- 1. The name Matthew means "g\_\_\_\_\_ of the Lord"
  - a. His name was originally L\_\_\_\_\_
  - b. Matthew was his n\_\_\_\_\_
- 2. Matthew was a tax collector for the R\_\_\_\_\_ government.
  - a. Tax collectors were given the power to set any r\_\_\_\_\_ they wanted as long as the government got its quota.
  - b. Tax collectors were w\_\_\_\_\_ because they overcharged the Jewish people.
  - c. Tax collectors were Jews, but were considered to be o\_\_\_\_\_ the kingdom of God.
- 3. Matthew did not d\_\_\_\_\_\_ to be called by Jesus
- •How does Christ personally call us to follow Him today?
  - 1. It is a c\_\_\_\_\_ calling (Jn 15:16 He chooses us)
  - 2. It is through the g\_\_\_\_\_ message (1Pet 2:9; 2Thess 2:14)
- •Have you thanked Jesus for His gift to you?

## Is without discrimination (10,11)

- •Matthew threw an open-house party for Jesus (Lk 5:29), which attracted various groups
  - 1. Tax collectors
  - 2. S\_\_\_\_\_\_ those who made a living that compromised the Law of Moses (e.g. prostitutes, pig farmers)

- 3. D\_\_\_\_\_ in this context, they were His closest followers and by this time included Peter, Andrew, James, John, Philip, Nathanael.
- 4. P\_\_\_\_\_\_ a Jewish sect who held to the letter of the Law of Moses as well as to traditional rules which insured against the remote possibility of breaking God's laws (e.g. no s\_\_\_\_\_ on the ground on the Sabbath; a woman cannot look in a m\_\_\_\_\_ on the Sabbath).

•The Pharisees criticize Jesus for e\_\_\_\_\_ with tax collectors and sinners.

- 1. Jesus responds by saying that the s\_\_\_\_\_ need a doctor. a. The sick - \_\_\_\_\_

  - b. The doctor \_\_\_\_\_
- 2. Jesus ministered to all g\_\_\_\_\_ of people in order to bring them to a right relationship with God (rich and poor, the religious and outcasts, young and old, men and women, etc). He did not discriminate.

•The h\_\_\_\_\_ of the gospel is to save people from all walks of life.

- 1. Matt 28:18 make disciples of all the n\_\_\_\_\_ (ethnos)
- 2. Matt 24:14 the g\_\_\_\_\_ must be preached to all the nations (ethnos) before Jesus returns.
- 3. Jn 10:16 Jesus will unite His folds of sheep into one f
- 4. Rev 5:9,10 envisions Jesus effectively purchasing with His b\_\_\_\_\_ people from every tribe, tongue, nation, and class.
- 5. Rev 7:9 envisions people from every walk of life w\_\_\_\_\_ before the throne of God.
- •We must not discriminate in s\_\_\_\_\_ the gospel with others
  - 1. The religious Jehovah's Witnesses, Mormons, Hindus, Moslems, witches, etc.
  - 2. The outcasts criminals, homosexuals, transvestites, etc.
  - 3. "Normal" people

## Is to the sinner (12,13)

- Jesus quotes Hosea 6:6
  - 1. He tells the Pharisees to go and l\_\_\_\_\_ what this passage means.
    - a. The passage was written to N. Israel who kept the sacrificial laws but had no m\_\_\_\_\_ toward others.

- b. The Pharisees kept the letter of the Law, but had no m\_\_\_\_\_ toward those who did not measure up to their standards.
- 2. What good is it to do the rituals, if it does not transfer into relating rightly with our fellowman?
- •Jesus explains that He came not to call the righteous but the sinners.
  - 1. The righteous those who think they are okay because of what they do (s\_\_\_\_\_- righteous)
  - 2. The sinners those who know they are not okay because of what they've done.

•Before anyone can come to Christ, they must first realize that they are a s\_\_\_\_\_\_ and are in need of Christ to bring them into a right relationship with God.

- •What demonstrates that you are grateful for Jesus calling you? (remember His call to follow Him is an undeserved gift)
- •What are you doing to extend the gospel to people from ALL walks of life? (praying, giving, and sharing)
- •Have you come to a point in your life where you have realized you are a sinner and are in need of Christ in bringing you into a right relationship with God?
