Matthew 22:23-33

Introduction:

- Spot the error Joe thought the elephant was pink, but he was mistakened.
- Who wants to be mistaken?
- 1. We can live with some mistakes but we do not want to be mistaken about God, life choices, and everyday living.
- 2. In today's lesson Jesus points out the error of the Sadducees that caused them to be mistaken about God and life. Let's learn from their error and heed the words of Jesus.

• Who were the Sadducees? (v. 23)
1. They were part of the ruling class of the Jews.
2. They believed that only the first books of the Old Testament were inspired by God.
3. Except for, they did not believe angels, demons, or the spirits of dead people to exist.
4. They believed that d was the final state of a person, a state of nothingness.
• The Sadducees ask Jesus to apply the law of Deut 25:5 to a hypothetical situation (vv. 24-28)
1. The Law – If a man marries a woman and dies leaving her childless, the c
relative must marry the woman and raise up children from her.
2. The hypothetical situation – A man has brothers. He marries a woman and dies, leaving
her childless. One brother marries the woman but also dies leaving her childless. This happens to all
the brothers.
3. The question - Whose wife will she be in the r?
4. The hopes of the Sadducees was to s Jesus and to show that the resurrection of the
dead was ridiculous.
 Jesus's first answer – you are mistaken, not understanding the Scriptures (vv. 29, 30)

a. R it and accept all of it as truth.
b. P for understanding as you read, study, and discuss God's word with others.
c. A upon God's word (Matt 4:4; Ps 119:11)

Understand the Power of God
• Jesus's second answer – you are mistaken…not understanding the p of God.
1. Jesus quotes Exodus 3:6 where God tells Moses, <i>I</i> the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.
a. If Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob were in a state of nothingness, He would have said, I the
God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.
b. Therefore, they must be in some state of existence. Their s must be alive.
2. God has the power to raise people from the dead and He will!
• Application
1. "Science" mocks the creation account in Genesis 1 because it does not understand the power of
God.
a. Science
1) The s is the source which sustains all life
2) P were created on the third day, but the sun was not created until the fourth
day, a scientific impossibility
b. The power of God
1) God created l on the first day (v. 2) and separated the light from the
darkness. What held this light in place? –
2) God created light b (Hebrew word) on the fourth day (v. 14) to separate the
light from the darkness. God transferred His power to these light bearers: the sun, moon, and stars.
2. Some challenge the reality that God is all-powerful because they do not understand that power.
a. Challengers – if God is all-powerful why does He not put a stop to e?
b. The Scriptural truth
1) Rom 8:28 - God works all things out for the g of those who love Him (that
includes evil things)
2) Rev 21:1-8 – God will c a new world for believers to live on where evil will
never exist.
3) God stop all evil. And He will, just not today (or until He has completed His plan to
save people from every ethnicity – Matt 24:14)
