- A wrong question to ask: *How long have you been a Christian?*
 1. Some people think that certain acts make them a Christian and that they do not need to c_____.
 - a. I prayed the sinner's prayer.
 - b. I went forward in a church service.
 - c. I was baptized.
 2. The above people would answer this question differently:
how long have been living the Christian life?
- A spiritual overseer must not be a new c_____ (KJV – *novice*). Why?
 1. He might become c_____

- Three interpretations
 1. NAS, KJV, ESV – fall into the same condemnation that the devil received.
 - a. This presents a picture of a person's salvation as being f_____
 - b. The larger context of the Bible presents a person's salvation as s_____.

 - 2) Jesus said in Jn 10:28 that He will never allow any
believer to p_____ and no one will be able to
snatch a believer from His hands.
2. NIV – fall into the same judgment as the devil.
- a. The Greek language distinguishes between *judgment* (krima) and *condemnation* (kata+krima) by putting a prefix before the word judgment (see I Cor 11:32 where judgment refers to God’s d_____ to keep a person from being condemned).
 - b. This interpretation sees God’s discipline as removing the conceited leader from l_____, just as He removed the devil from his high position as an angel.
 - c. The larger context of the Bible has God leaving it up to the church body to qualify and disqualify leaders.
3. NLT – the devil causes the conceited leader to fall
- a. Although this is the better understanding, it falls short of the point.
 - b. The point
 - 1) A leader’s conceit would cause him to f_____
 - 2) A conceited leader would fall into, literally, *the judgment of the devil*.
 - a) Not in the sense that the devil judges the leader.
 - b) But in the sense that the leader makes judgments that the devil would make – devil____ judgments (look at the devil’s judgments in Gen 3).
 - c. Wester’s paraphrase – *not a new convert, lest in becoming puffed-up with pride, he fall into devilish judgment*.
