## Living by Faith and not by Sight

Judges 6:17-40

## Introduction:

A. In moments of indecision, what should we do?

- 1. Setting out a f\_\_\_\_\_ was not an act of faith by Gideon. Nowhere in the Bible is this kind of act encouraged.
- 2. We certainly should p\_\_\_\_\_ but in such a way that exhibits faith, not doubt.
- B. Today we will learn what it means to live by faith and not by sight. Are you living by faith?

## Faith is based on the reality of God (17-27)

- A. Gideon asked for a s\_\_\_\_\_ from the angel of the Lord to prove His identity.
  - 1. A sign is something unusual or miraculous that is used to indicate something.
    - a. Unusual Lk 2:12 gives the shepherds the sign that would indicate who the Christ child was a babe wrapped in strips of cloth and lying in a m\_\_\_\_\_.
    - b. Miraculous Ex 7:3 tells us that God multiplied His signs (the ten plagues) in Egypt to indicate His supreme p\_\_\_\_\_.
  - 2. The angel of the Lord did a miraculous sign
    - a. Fire from a r\_\_\_\_\_ that consumed Gideon's sacrifice.
    - b. He \_\_\_\_\_\_ before Gideon's eyes.
  - 3. Gideon's response was one of f
    - a. I have seen the angel of the Lord face to face!
    - b. He then o \_\_\_\_\_ God's command to tear down his father's pagan altars which his father made for the townfolk.
- B. Application God expects us to apply t\_\_\_\_\_ to make sure our faith is based on reality and not illusion.
  - 1. We must test those who claim to be p\_\_\_\_\_
    - a) Deut 18:22 must be 100% accurate in all p\_\_\_\_\_.
    - b) Deut 13:1-3 must be 100% consistent with God's w\_\_\_\_\_.
  - 2. I Jn 4:4 we are to test the s\_\_\_\_\_ to see if they are really from God or not because of the many false prophets in the world.
    - a) Jehovah's Witnesses deny the d\_\_\_\_\_ of Jesus, the sufficiency of His saving work, His physical resurrection from the dead, and more (contradicts God's word)
    - b) Mormons believe in many gods and teach that faithful Mormons can become a god and rule their own p\_\_\_\_\_.

## Doubt is based on the illusion of sight

- A. What caused Gideon to have his faith shaken? what he s\_\_\_\_\_
  - a. The Midianite army and their a \_\_\_\_\_ assembled against Israel in the Valley of Jezreel (the number was astronomical).
  - b. Gideon gathered \_\_\_\_\_ men for this battle (see 7:3)
- B. What did Gideon do to deal with his doubts? set out a f\_\_\_\_\_ of wool.
  - a. This act itself cast doubt on God's w\_\_\_\_\_- *if you are going to deliver Israel through me*
  - b. Gideon's terms cast demands on God to w\_\_\_\_\_ in a certain way:
    - 1) Make the fleece wet by the m\_\_\_\_\_ dew and the floor around it dry.
    - Make the fleece dry and the floor around it wet by the e\_\_\_\_\_ dew.
- C. Did the fleece setting rid Gideon of his doubts?
  - a. One fleece test was not enough and so he demanded another.
  - b. After the second test, Gideon had \_\_\_\_\_ response (contrast this to his response after the angel of the Lord proved His identity in verse 22)
  - c. He did no more tests because he had to learn to live by faith and not by s\_\_\_\_\_.
