## A Christmas Lesson From the Magi Matthew 2:1-18

## M\_\_\_\_\_ of the Magi

- A. We three kings from orient are
  - 1. The Bible never tells us how many magi there were. It was a conclusion based on the number of g\_\_\_\_\_.
  - 2. The Bible never tells us that these men were kings. They were wisemen or magi, which were pagan s who served in the royal court.
- B. Following yonder star
  - 1. The Bible never states that they followed the star to Jerusalem, only to B .
  - 2. Some try to make the star a natural phenomenon, like the result of the alignment of Jupiter and Saturn. The star was supernatural, like the p\_\_\_\_\_ of cloud or fire that led the Israelites).

## M of the Magi

- A. We have seen His star in the east
  - 1. The scriptures do not p\_\_\_\_\_ of such a star (some point out Num 24:17, but Matthew would have pointed this out if it were so since that was his writing style).
  - The scriptures only record the magi as seeing this star. 2.
  - 3. The only prophetic voice that magi in that area received was in the days of Daniel who, in their history, was the c\_\_\_\_\_ of the magi (Dan 5:11).
    - a. Under the B\_\_\_\_\_ king, Nebuchadnezzar (Dan 2:47)
    - b. Under the M\_\_\_\_\_king, Darius (Dan 6:26)
    - c. Under the P\_\_\_\_\_ king, Cyrus (Dan 6:28)
- B. We have come to worship Him
  - 1. The influence of Daniel, the chief of the magi, was preserved through g\_\_\_\_\_ of magi who understood the King of the Jews to be God in the flesh.
  - 2. The Old Testament scriptures allude to the deity of the coming Messiah (Is 9:6 – *He will be called...the mighty* .)
- C. How have you come to an understanding of who God is?

## The M\_\_\_\_\_ of the Magi

- A. They announced the c\_\_\_\_\_ of the Messiah.
- B. They worshipped the p\_\_\_\_\_ of the Messiah.
- C. They obeyed the \_\_\_\_\_ of the Messiah.
