I Corinthians 10:1-5

- **Introduction:** Have you ever thought that things would be wonderful if...? A. You just had more money 2. You just had a better car You just had better health 3. You just had a better.... 4. Today, let's indulge in those thoughts as we see what ancient Israel had in the days of Moses. Wouldn't it be B. wonderful if we had what they had? Yahweh's Visible Presence (1a,2a) The period of the E\_ A. Joseph brought his family (the sons of Israel) to Egypt to escape \_\_\_\_\_ years of famine. 2. The sons of Israel stayed in Egypt for over \_\_\_\_\_ years. As the sons of Israel multiplied, Egypt e\_\_\_\_\_ them. 3. The sons of Israel cried out to God for deliverance and God raised up M\_\_\_\_\_ to free them. 4. Pharaoh refused to let this happen, so God put \_\_\_\_\_ plagues on Egypt before Pharaoh let the people go. 5. God led the people out of Egypt with a pillar of c\_\_\_\_\_ (by day) and f\_\_\_\_ (by night) which 6. was always visible to them. Verse 1a states that all of Israel was u\_\_\_\_\_ the cloud, which refers to the pillar of cloud. B. Ex 13:21 identifies the pillar of cloud and fire as being \_\_\_\_\_ 1. Verse 2 uses the term b\_ 2. All were baptized INTO M in the cloud See a similar phrase in Rom 6:3 (baptized into Christ) and 1 Cor 12:13 (baptized into one b ) carrying the idea of being identified with Christ and with the body of Christ. All were identified with Moses (NLT – f\_\_\_\_\_ of Moses). The baptism was IN the cloud b. The word baptism means to \_\_\_\_\_\_ or to saturate. Thus all of Israel was s\_\_\_\_\_ by the Lord's presence in a visible way. C. Wouldn't it be wonderful if we could physically see the Lord's presence all the time? Yahweh's Miraculous Protection (1b,2b) Verse 1b states that the Israelites passed through the s\_\_\_\_\_ A. Pharaoh w from a high elevation the parting and the continued journey of the Israelites. 1. Pharaoh saw that they were not traveling in c\_\_\_\_\_ and decided to pursue them with his army and kill 2. The pillar of cloud stopped the army from coming n\_\_\_\_\_ to the Israelites who were at the edge of a 3. 4. God parted the waters and as verse 1b states all of Israel passed through the sea. Verse 2 states that Israel was baptized IN the sea (they were completely surrounded by the sea and never got w\_\_\_\_!). After completing the crossing, the pillar of cloud l and Pharaoh's army began crossing b. so as to attack Israel. God collapsed the sea onto the Egyptian army and drowned them, not leaving alive. c. The news of this spread extreme f\_\_\_\_\_ to other nations (see Josh 2:11). d. Wouldn't it be wonderful if we had the Lord's miraculous protection? B. Yahweh's Supernatural Provisions (3.4)
- A. The people of Israel exited from a fertile land into the w\_\_\_\_\_ where water, trees, and food were scarce.
  - 1. God sustained this massive group of people for \_\_\_\_\_ years in the wilderness.
  - 2. Verse 3 states that all of Israel ate the same spiritual food and that food was called m\_\_\_\_\_ (Ex 16) God fed them in a supernatural way.
  - 3. Verse 4 states that all of Israel drank the same spiritual drink.
    - a. God provided water from a r\_\_\_\_\_ on more than one occasion.

		b. He calls the rock C to emphasize that the rock did not naturally contain water, but Christ was the source.
		c. God satisfied Israel's thirst in a supernatural way.

A.	If you h	ad Yahweh's visible supernatural presence, His constant supernatural protection, and His supernatural

	1.	You would never f alone because you could always see Him with your own eyes.
	2.	You would never f anything because God would miraculously protect you.
	3.	You would never worry about f or drink because God would supernaturally feed you.
	4.	You most certainly grow spiritually by leaps and bounds!
B.	Israel h	ad all the above but verse 5 states that most of them displeased God. Why? Because they were people who
	looked	at their circumstances and would think – "Wouldn't be wonderful if"
	1.	Whenever anything went wrong, they would say – we were better off in E
	2.	In Egypt, they did not see God, did not have that miraculous protection, nor were they fed supernaturally.
		They c out for God to get them out of Egypt!
	3.	Israel's constant complaining resulting in then being "laid low" in the wilderness (KJV – overthrown in
		the wilderness; NIV – bodies scattered over the wilderness). – they were all disqualified from entering the
		Pland but were doomed to wander in the wilderness for the rest of their lives.

	what yo	u do have.

		provisions while on this earth (Phil 4:19; Matt 6:33).
