# GOD'S DISCIPLINE

I Cor 11:30-32; Heb 12:4-13

#### Introduction:

- A. Questions to consider Has God ever disciplined you? How do you know when He is? How far will God go in keeping us?
- B. Let's learn about God's discipline and determine to r\_\_\_\_\_ immediately whenever we are disciplined by Him.

# God disciplines His c\_\_\_\_\_

- A. God does not i\_\_\_\_\_ our sin, but He f\_\_\_\_\_ it.
  - 1. Forgiveness happens i\_\_\_\_\_
  - 2. God does not w\_\_\_\_\_ for us to repent before forgiving us – He cleanses us from ALL unrighteousness (1 Jn 1:9).

# B. How can you know if God is disciplining you?

- 1. You might think that God is disciplining you and be w\_\_\_\_\_ (this is common)
- 2. But you will never experience God's discipline without knowing it.
  - a. Jonah knew that he was being disciplined by God for refusing to p\_\_\_\_\_ to the Ninevites (Jonah 1 & 2)
  - b. The Corinthians knew that they were being disciplined by God (1 Cor 11:30).
- C. Do not take lightly the discipline of God (Heb 12:5)
  - 1. It usually starts with g\_\_\_\_\_
  - into your life if you 2. He may bring a persist in sin (Heb 12:12,13)
  - 3. But understand that all discipline is out of 1\_\_\_\_\_ for us as His children (Heb 12:6-8)

# God disciplines for a p\_\_\_\_\_

A. God disciplines us to prevent us from being c\_\_\_\_\_

- (1 Cor 11:21,32)
- 1. He gave us e\_\_\_\_\_ life at the moment of faith.
- 2. God will c\_\_\_\_\_ His work of salvation in all His children (Phil 1:6).
- B. God disciplines us to r\_\_\_\_\_ to a useful condition
  - God does not enjoy the m\_\_\_\_\_ of discipline.
     God enjoys the r\_\_\_\_\_ of discipline.

     a. Restores the j\_\_\_\_\_ of our salvation to us.
- b. Restores our u\_\_\_\_\_ to Him.
