- A. Many differentiate between the spiritual gift of tongues and praying in tongues.
 - 1. Some propose that everyone can p______ in tongues but not everyone is given the spiritual g______ of tongues.
 - Some propose that praying in tongues should be a spiritual d_____.
 - 3. 1 Cor 11 has much to say about this. Will you accept what God says about this?
- B. A verse-by-verse understanding
 - 1. Paul begins the chapter with a command (v. 1):
 - a. P_____ (run after) agape love (the motivation we are to have behind all that we do)
 - b. But earnestly d______ spiritual gifts is better translated be zealous of spiritual gifts (i.e. the abilities designed by God to build up the church body)
 - c. Especially (KJV rather) that you p_____
 - The Greek word translated as *especially* or *rather* is a word of c_____ (some, more, most)
 - But how can a person be zealous to prophesy if no prophecy is an act of human w_____ (2 Pet 1:21)?
 - 2. Paul continues with an e______ of what he means by prophesying as is indicated by the word, "For"
 - a. A person who speaks in a t_____ (as the Corinthians practiced it) were not speaking to people but to God since no one could understand what was being said (v. 2)
 - This cannot be talking about the spiritual gift of tongues since the spiritual gift of tongues was spoken to m_____ and not to God and could be understood by the unbeliever (see Acts 2:8)
 - 2) This must be talking about the emotional babbling that was being practiced in the Corinthian church which did not edify anyone except o_____.
 - b. A person who prophesies speaks to people and edifies (or builds up) the c_____ (vv. 3,4)
 - 3. Paul wants the Corinthians to speak in tongues not in the nonsense of babbling but in the sense of p_____ (v. 5).
 - a. Tongues is only beneficial if it is a word of r_____, knowledge, prophecy, or teaching (v. 6).

- b. Paul is equating true tongues with prophecy (which edifies the church)
- 4. Paul gives an illustration (vv. 7,8)
 - a. With playing m_____ (v. 7) a melody for others to hear as opposed to producing indistinct tones.
 - b. With a call to b_____ (v. 8) an army needs to hear the notes.
- 5. Paul applies the illustration (vv. 9-12)
 - a. Speech has to be c______ so that people can know what is being said (v. 9)
 - b. Every language in the world has m_____, but only to the one who knows it. (v. 10)
 - c. Imagine two people who do not know one another's language trying to speak to one another. What would they sound like to one another? (v. 11) _____
 - d. Therefore, be zealous for the spiritual gifts that b_____ the people of the church.
- 6. Paul deals with praying in tongues (vv. 13-19)
 - a. He shows that it is better to pray with u_____ than to pray in tongues without understanding (vv. 13-15)
 - b. He emphasizes that praying in tongues in earshot of others does not e_____ anyone but oneself (vv. 16,17)
 - c. He shows that it is better to speak f_____ words that people can understand instead of 1,000 words that they cannot understand (vv. 18,19)
- 7. Paul gives scriptural understanding about the gift of tongues and of prophecy (vv. 20-33)
 - a. The spiritual gift of tongues are a s_____ to unbelievers.
 - If the whole church assembles and everyone speaks in nonsensical tongues when unbelievers are visiting, they will say that you are c_____.(v. 23)
 - If the whole church assembles and everyone prophesies to a visiting unbeliever (i.e. speaks in the unbeliever's language which they have never learned), he will be convicted and declare that God is surely a_____you.
 - b. All things must be done for the purpose of edification, which means b_____ up the people of the church.
 - If the spiritual gift of tongues is truly given, then not all will be speaking at once, but each person will speak in t______(v. 27)

- If the spiritual gift of tongues is truly given, then there will be an i______ so that all will be built up (v. 27)
- If a person prays in a tongue (babbles), then he must keep s_____ as he prays to God. (v. 28) notice that Paul does not condemn such praying.
- c. True prophecy will be done in an orderly fashion because God is not a God of c_____ but of peace (vv 29-33).
- C. Conclusion:
 - 1. Praying in tongues is not the s_____ as the spiritual gift of speaking in tongues.
 - There is nothing wrong with being emotional to the point of just babbling to God as long as it is done s_____ within one's spirit.
 - 3. It is much more spiritual to pray with u_____ than to pray in tongues.
 - 4. No one should forbid the exercise of the spiritual gift of tongues (v. 39)
