#### **The Veil** 2 Corinthians 3:5-18

#### Introduction:

- A. The Wiccan website gives their belief about Halloween
  - 1. It is one of two nights out of the year in which the veil that separates the natural world from the spiritual world is 1
  - 2. It is a time for people to communicate to d\_\_\_\_\_\_loved ones.
  - 3. It is a time to s\_\_\_\_\_ the Dark Mysteries and honor the Dark Mother and the Dark Father.
  - It originated from the Celtics who practiced putting out f\_\_\_\_\_\_ offerings for the wandering dead.
  - 5. It is also a night of chaos, where the Wee Folke pull p\_\_\_\_\_\_ on unsuspecting people. The early church adopted practices to scare away these spirits which they deemed as evil.
- B. The truth: there is a veil that exists:

Having therefore such a hope, we use great boldness in *our* speech, and *are* not as Moses, *who* used to put a **veil** over his face that the sons of Israel might not look intently at the end of what was fading away. But their minds were hardened; for until this very day at the reading of the old covenant the **same veil** remains unlifted, because it is removed in Christ. But to this day whenever Moses is read, a **veil** lies over their heart. (2 Cor 3:12-15; NAS).

# The symbolic veil (v. 12)

- A. Why did Moses put a veil over his face? (see Ex 33 and 34)
  - 1. The situation:
    - a. Moses was receiving from God words of the c\_\_\_\_\_ that was to be made between the Lord and the people.
    - b. He asked God if he could see His f\_\_\_\_\_, but God said that one could see it and live.
    - c. God allowed Moses to see His b\_\_\_\_\_ and so caught a reflection of God's glory.
    - d. God's glory caused Moses' face to s\_\_\_\_\_ brightly which scared the people.
  - 2. The solution: Moses put a veil over his face as he presented the covenant to the people.

- B. Under the Old Covenant a t\_\_\_\_\_ was constructed according to God's dimensions.
  - 1. A veil was to be made and hung to b\_\_\_\_\_ the entrance to the inner sanctuary known as the Holy of Holies where the glory of God would appear from time to time.
  - 2. This m\_\_\_\_\_ temple was packed up and moved to wherever the people of Israel went.
- C. The Lord had King S\_\_\_\_\_ build a temple in Jerusalem according to similar design as the tabernacle (1 Kg 5:5 and chapter 6).
  - a. The temple was d\_\_\_\_\_\_ 360 years later and then rebuilt 82 years after that.
  - b. In 20 B.C., King Herod the Great ordered that the temple be expanded and upgraded which took \_\_\_\_\_ years (Josephus; Jn 2:20).
  - c. According to the Mishnah (a Jewish writing documenting oral tradition of the Jews), the temple veil measured 60 feet high, 30 feet wide, and had the thickness of a man's p\_\_\_\_\_.
- D. The veil was symbolic of the separation between God and mankind due to mankind's s\_\_\_\_\_.

# The spiritual veil (v. 15)

- A. The spiritual reality is that a veil lies over the h\_\_\_\_\_ of all unbelievers.
  - 1. Reading Moses did not l\_\_\_\_\_ the veil from the heart of the Jews.
  - 2 Cor 4:3,4 states that the gospel is veiled to unbelievers whom Satan has blinded so that they cannot see the l\_\_\_\_\_ of the gospel of the glory of Christ.
- B. There are many religious people who don't realize that a veil lies over their heart keeping them separated from God.
  - 1. The Pharisees thought they could spiritually s\_\_\_\_\_ but were in reality spiritually blind (Jn 9:39-41).
  - Doing religious things, though they be good things, does not remove the veil because salvation from our sin is not by w\_\_\_\_\_(Eph 2:8,9)

#### The solution that removes the veil (v. 16)

- A. When a person t\_\_\_\_\_\_ to the Lord, the veil is removed.
  - 1. This requires a person to change d\_\_\_\_\_
  - 2. The turning is repenting from sin and trusting in Christ to be your God and Savior.
- B. Jesus purposely went to the cross to pay the r\_\_\_\_\_ for the sins of those who trust Him (Matt 20:28)
  - 1. He cried out on the cross that the Father had \_\_\_\_\_\_ Him (He was paying the price for our sin) – Matt 27:46
  - 2. He cried out that it was f\_\_\_\_\_ (the payment was complete) Jn 19:30
- C. The veil of the temple was torn from t\_\_\_\_\_ to b\_\_\_\_\_ (Matt 27:51)
  - 1. This was not a n\_\_\_\_\_ tear due to overuse by priests (remember the veil was 60 feet high).
  - 2. This was a supernatural phenomenon communicating a symbolic message that the veil separating one from God is removed only in C\_\_\_\_\_.
  - 3. The resurrection of Jesus p\_\_\_\_\_ that Jesus' sin payment was successful.

# Conclusion

- A. Obsess over the d\_\_\_\_\_ of Christ (Jn 3:16; 17:3)
- B. Obsess over the m\_\_\_\_\_ of Christ that ONLY in Him can the veil be removed.
- C. A Halloween opportunity: give out the Eternal Life Tract
