#### **BEHOLD! HE IS COMING!**

Revelation 1:7,8

#### Introduction:

A. Predictions of Christ's coming

- 1. The Great D\_\_\_\_\_
  - a. People waited on their rooftops for Christ to return between Mar 21, 1843 and Oct 22, 1843 believing Pastor William Millers calculations.
  - b. Miller was puzzled as to how he was wrong.
- 2. A s\_\_\_\_\_ return
  - a. Mary Ellen White's writings on a spiritual return launched the Ad\_\_\_\_\_ist movement (mid 1800's)
  - b. Charles Russell was disappointed with historic Christianity and searched for alternate meanings of words in Scripture to support his ideas.
    - 1) H\_\_\_\_\_ means grave and so there is no eternal punishment.
    - 2) Announced the i\_\_\_\_\_return of Christ in 1914 to rule through the "faithful and discreet slave" called the Watch Tower Society.
- 3. Over \_\_\_\_\_ different dates of Christ's coming have been predicted over the centuries
- B. The doctrine of Christ's coming is c\_\_\_\_, not confusing.
  - 1. Jesus has not come yet, but *Behold! He is coming* (Rev 1:7)
  - 2. The word behold means to take a g\_\_\_\_\_ look. Today, we will take a good look at this revelation which outlines three actions we are to take in regard to His coming.

## L\_\_\_\_\_ how He is coming (7a)

- A. John uses Old Testament l\_\_\_\_\_ from two passages to describe the second coming of Jesus
  - 1. Behold! He is coming with the clouds- Dan 7:13
    - a. Dan 7:13 is a prophecy of one l\_\_\_\_\_ a son of man who would rule all people forever.
    - b. Jesus used similar phraseology on two occasions:
      - Matt 24:30; Mk 13:26 He told His disciples about His s\_\_\_\_\_ coming.
      - 2) Mark 14:62 At His trial, He told the High Priest that He was the C\_\_\_\_\_.

- 2. And every eye will see Him, even those who pierced Him. And all the tribes of the earth will mourn over Him – language derived from Zech 12:10,12
- B. Three types of prophetic fulfillment
  - 1. Predictive the original prophecy f\_\_\_\_\_ of a future event (e.g Mic 5:2 the birthplace of the Messiah)
  - Typological the original prophecy f\_\_\_\_\_\_ something in the future but the original readers were not told this. God revealed this later (e.g. Ex 12:46 & Jn 19:36 – Jesus fulfilled the type of the Passover Lamb).
  - 3. Illustrative language from an O.T. passage is used to describe a current event
    - a. Matt 2:16 alludes to Jer 31:15 to describe Herod's slaughter of i\_\_\_\_\_ but Jer 31:15 is about the loss of the 10 tribes of Israel.
    - b. Jesus referred Ps 8:2 to illustrate the children shouting praising Him *out of the mouth of b\_\_\_\_\_*
    - c. We use prophecy this way sometimes *the handwriting is on the w\_\_\_\_\_* comes from Daniel 5.
- C. Rev 1:7 uses the language of Dan 7:13 and Zech 12:10,12 to illustrate the n\_\_\_\_\_ of Jesus's second coming.
  - 1. His return will be v\_\_\_\_\_ to everyone
  - 2. Jesus warned against people promoting a false teaching of an i\_\_\_\_\_ return (Matt 24:23-27).
  - 3. The New Testament clearly teaches that Jesus's second coming will be visible:
    - a. Acts 1:11 Jesus will return the same way as the disciples saw Him a\_\_\_\_\_ into the sky.
    - b. 1 Thess 4:16,17 that Jesus would d\_\_\_\_\_\_ from heaven and believers would join Him in the sky.
    - c. Rev 1:7 Behold! Look! He is coming with the clouds!

## Turn before His coming (7b)

- A. The reaction of the unbelieving world to Christ's coming
  - 1. *Those who pierced Him* is O.T. language that illustrates unbelievers s\_\_\_\_\_\_ Jesus return.
  - 2. All the tribes of the earth will mourn over Him is O.T. language that illustrates the unbelieving world's realization of Jesus being the Christ and Savior.

- 3. Rev 6:6,17 prophesies that the unbelieving world will cry out for the rocks and the mountains to h them from the Lamb of God to avoid His wrath.
- B. If you have not turned to Christ
  - 1. Do so now before it is too late!
  - 2. Don't be afraid to ask questions so that you can see that trusting Christ is the step to take
- C. If you have turned to Christ
  - 1. Remember who you are God's p to the unbelieving world
  - 2. A\_\_\_\_\_\_ an unbeliever's spiritual questions (find out the answer if you don't know it).
  - 3. Don't let f or inadequacy keep you from explaining Jesus to unbelievers (it is not about you, but about them and Jesus).

# Yearn for His coming (7c, 8)

- A. Comparing translations
  - 1. NLT has the most literal translation Yes! Amen.
  - 2. These are words of a
- B. What is the agreement over?
  - 1. It is NOT with the mourning of the unbelieving world

  - 2. It is with the f \_\_\_\_\_\_ of Jesus's cominga. John is y \_\_\_\_\_\_ for Jesus to come (Rev 22:20)
    - b. Are you yearning for Jesus to come?
- C. Why has Jesus not come yet? (2 Pet 3:9-11)
  - 1. Because God is p\_\_\_\_\_ toward believers in living holy and godly lives.
  - 2. Because God's plan is to save people from every tribe, tongue, nation, and kind (Rev 5:9,10 – He WILL bring all these to repentance)
  - 3. We can s\_\_\_\_\_ up the time of His return by living holy lives (serving God's purposes) and godly lives (godly, literally means good worship).

- A. "I am the Alpha and the Omega," says the Lord God, everything begins and ends with Him.
- B. "Who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty!" -Behold! He is coming!
