# THE LAST TRUMPET: WHAT ARE YOU REALLY LOOKING FOR?

#### Revelation 11:15-19

#### Introduction:

- A. Every generation of Christians has hoped for Christ's
  - r\_\_\_\_\_ in their lifetime.
  - 1. Opponents of Christianity m\_\_\_\_\_ the teaching of Christ's return (2 Pet 3:3,4)
  - 2. Jesus cannot return until certain c\_\_\_\_\_ are met.
  - 3. What are you really looking for?
- B. A review of the releasing of the seven seals
  - 1. The first five seals have already occurred or are occurring
    - a. First seal g\_\_\_\_\_ conquering evil (e.g. the gospel conquering people's hearts)
    - b. Second seal world p\_\_\_\_\_ taken away
    - c. Third seal severe d\_\_\_\_\_ that brings economic hardship.
    - d. Fourth seal death to ¼ of the world by s\_\_\_\_\_ (the rise of Islam), famines, and plagues by wild animals (e.g. bubonic plague).
    - e. Fifth seal believers dying for the f\_\_\_\_\_
  - The sixth seal is yet f\_\_\_\_\_ from our standpoint this is when the unbelieving world will realize that the Day of w\_\_\_\_\_ (God's and the Lamb's) has come.
  - The seventh seal is the f\_\_\_\_\_ seal and reveals the details of how terrible that day is going to be for unbelievers and is divided into seven t\_\_\_\_\_.
    - a. The first four trumpets
      - 1) Occurs after God is done s\_\_\_\_\_ (i.e. saving) all that He is going to seal (7:1-3; 8:7).
      - 2) One-t\_\_\_\_\_ of the earth is affected.
    - b. The last three trumpets are three woes.
      - The fifth trumpet (the first woe) those who do not have God's seal are tortured for \_\_\_\_\_ months.
      - 2) The sixth trumpet (the second woe)  $\overline{}$ 
        - a) Plagues are put on the unbelieving world and kill 1/3 of them, but no one r\_\_\_\_\_.

- b) Believers are persecuted for \_\_\_\_\_ months by the world while the unbelieving world is terrorized by t\_\_\_\_\_ prophets for 1260 days.
- c) Unbelievers finally give glory to God in t\_\_\_\_\_.
- 3) The seventh trumpet (the third woe) today's study)
  - a) This is when the body of dead believers will ber\_\_\_\_\_ up first (1Thess 4:15,16)
  - b) Then the alive believers will be r\_\_\_\_\_ up to Jesus who is in the air (1Thess 4:17)
  - c) Paul taught that the "change" of all believers (dead and alive) will occur at the l\_\_\_\_\_ trumptet.
- C. Believers are commanded in various parts of scripture to look for Christ's coming What are you really looking for?

#### The event of Christ's coming – He r\_\_\_\_\_(15-17)

- A. The announced changes
  - 1. Christ's k\_\_\_\_\_ is what reigns over the world (before the beastly empire ruled the world chapter 13)
  - 2. The Lord is called who was and who is
    - a. He is no longer described as *who is to come* as He was in Rev 1:4,8; 4:8.
    - b. The KJV follows a 12<sup>th</sup> century copy of Revelation that has *who is to come*. All copies prior to the 10<sup>th</sup> century only read *who is and who was*. Some scribe mistakenly thought it was an oversight and added *who is to come*. This error was then duplicated by other copyists.
    - c. When Christ finally comes, He will no longer be *who is to come*. But He will always be *who was and who is*.
- B. What we can look forward to
  - 1. No more in\_\_\_\_\_
  - 2. No more p\_\_\_\_\_
  - 3. No more corrupt p\_\_\_\_\_
  - 4. One perfect K\_\_\_\_\_

## The events following Christ's coming – He r\_\_\_\_\_(18)

A. Rev 11:18a – *the nations were enraged and your wrath came* (this is detailed in Rev 20)

- 1. Christ reigns unopposed for 1000 years because Satan is b\_\_\_\_\_\_so he CANNOT decieve the nations.
- 2. At the end of the 1000 years Satan is r\_\_\_\_\_ and deceives the nations into trying to takeover Christ's kingdom but the nations are consumed.
- B. Revelation 11:18b the time came for the dead to be judged and to reward...saints.
  - 1. The judging of the dead is detailed in Rev 20:11-15 the Lake of F
  - 2. The rewarding of the saints is detailed in Rev 21,22
- C. The rewards that await us are unimaginable (see 1Cor 2:9)

## Our actions up to Christ's coming – be r\_\_\_\_\_

- A. 2 Pet 3:11,12 we are to look for and hurry on Christ's coming by living:
  - 1. H\_\_\_\_\_ lives (living out your relationship with Jesus)
  - 2. G\_\_\_\_\_lives (living in a way that shows you are a good worshipper of God).
- B. Matt 24:44,45 we are to be ready for His coming by being faithful and sensible s\_\_\_\_\_.
- C. 1 Thess 5:6,11 we are to be alert in relationship to His coming by b\_\_\_\_\_ one another up.
  - 1. Diligently g\_\_\_\_\_ your encouragement, help, and prayers to the people of this church
  - 2. Humbly r\_\_\_\_\_ encouragement, help, and prayers from the people of this church.

## **Conclusion:**

- A. The sanctuary is o\_\_\_\_\_ up for all to see1. It contains the ark of H\_\_\_\_\_ covenant
  - - a. This is not the O\_\_\_\_\_ Covenant which was
    - constantly broken.b. This is the N\_\_\_\_\_ Covenant which Christ put into effect by fulfilling the Old Covenant (Heb 8:6,7; 9:15)
  - 2. The scene ends with mighty phenomenon of lightning, thunder, a shaking, and a great hailstorm - picture of God's awesome presence which we all will be able to stand before.
